My supervisor, Alberto Pantoja, continued to engage in unlawful retaliation against me, since I (and every ARS woman research scientist working for him) had filed complaints against him in an attempt to stop his unlawful harassment, discrimination, and retaliation against women.

- The position description of ARS technicians DOES NOT PROHIBIT co-authorship.
- My tech had a Master's degree in science and was an accomplished writer who met all of the journal's criteria for authorship.
- I provided all of the proper justifications that were required for co-authorship by ARS.
- It would be unethical for me (and in fact, any scientist) to submit a manuscript to a peer-reviewed journal without including the names of all the legitimate co-authors who had contributed to the work.

My supervisor ultimately carried out his (unethical and unlawful) threat against me by lowering the rating on my annual appraisal.
