However, the Agency sent YOU a certified letter (asking ME to Cease and Desist my website), and I just wanted to let you know that I've already written back to our pal Brooks Liswell, informing him that I'm no longer represented by Josephson and Associates. Please disregard his current certified letter.

However, in case they try to solicit your testimony against me, I hope you'll remember that on August 19th 2010, I said (repeatedly, and even in front of the EEOC negotiator) that I was planning to publish a book about what the ARS did to me. In fact, we crafted the language in the Settlement Agreement to make just such a publication possible.

Thanks for all your help in getting me this far. I'll take it from here, since I'm still unemployed in Kodiak (and I've got nothing better to do than spend my time fighting for women's rights against the ARS).
